ZORYVE cream 0.15% is a prescription medicine used on the skin (topical) to treat mild to moderate eczema (atopic dermatitis) in people 6 years of age and older. It is not known if ZORYVE cream 0.15% is safe and effective in children with mild to moderate eczema (atopic dermatitis)

Eczema may be more common than you think

Atopic dermatitis, a common form of eczema, is a chronic (recurring) inflammatory skin condition that affects up to 9.6 million children and 16.5 million adults.

APPEARANCE AND SYMPTOMS

Eczema affects people of all ages and **can appear on other locations on the body as you get older**. Symptoms include redness, irritation, and itching. Scratching further disrupts the skin barrier, exposing skin to irritants, infections, and allergens that can make eczema worse.

DAILY IMPACT

People with eczema are highly conscious of what touches their skin. Eczema can leave people feeling exposed and even change how they feel in their own skin and within their environment.

CAUSES

While the exact cause of eczema is unknown, **different genetic and environmental factors may affect eczema,** and triggers vary from person to person.

Myth: My eczema symptoms are due to my dietary choices. **Fact:** Eczema is highly influenced by genetics and other environmental factors, not just diet.

Myth: Eczema is a disease that only kids get.

Fact: Eczema symptoms can first appear at any age.

Myth: I can get rid of my eczema with the right treatment.

Fact: Eczema is a lifelong condition that needs ongoing symptom management.

Myth: Eczema affects everyone the same way.

Fact: Eczema can appear on skin almost anywhere. And how it looks and feels can vary from person to person.

ZORYVE can treat areas on the skin affected by eczema—face, eyelids, torso, hands, and feet.



IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION (CONT'D)

Before using ZORYVE, tell your healthcare provider about all of your medical conditions, including if you:

- have liver problems.
- are pregnant or plan to become pregnant. It is not known if ZORYVE will harm your unborn baby.
- are breastfeeding or plan to breastfeed. It is not known
 if ZORYVE passes into your breast milk. Talk to your
 healthcare provider about the best way to feed your
 baby during treatment with ZORYVE. Breastfeeding
 women using ZORYVE should use it on the smallest
 area of the skin and for the shortest time needed.
 Do not apply ZORYVE directly to the nipple or areola
 to avoid contact with your baby.



Rapid and reliable relief in a steroid-free cream

ZORYVE was evaluated as a once-daily, steroid-free, stand-alone treatment over the course of 4 weeks in 2 clinical trials of **1,337 people** aged 6 and older with mild to moderate eczema.

884 people used ZORYVE daily for 4 weeks. 453 people used the same cream without the active ingredient (the inactive cream) daily for 4 weeks.

CLEAR OR ALMOST CLEAR SKIN*

31% of people using ZORYVE had *Clear* or *Almost Clear* skin* in 4 weeks vs 14% of people using inactive cream



*People who had *Clear* or *Almost Clear* skin and a 2-point improvement on a 5-point severity scale. 0 = Clear, 1 = Almost Clear, 2 = Mild, 3 = Moderate, 4 = Severe.

APPLY

RUB IN

Rub the cream in completely until you no longer see it on your skin.



WASH HANDS

Wash your hands after, unless your hands are being treated. If someone else applies ZORYVE for you, they should wash their hands after applying ZORYVE.
